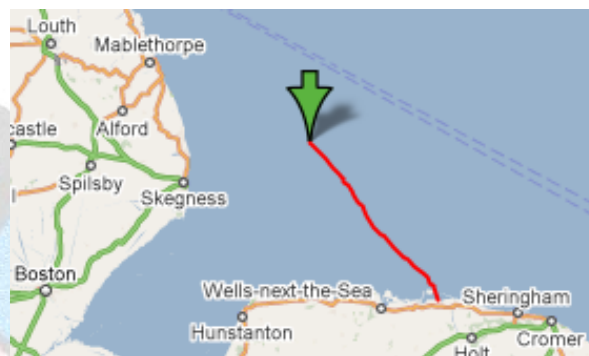

History: ~Built in 1906 by Howaldswerke of Keil, owned by A/S D/S Holm Denmark. Powered by two boilers and a triple expansion engine of 96hp, driving a single shaft. On passage San Juan for Middlesbrough with a cargo of Iron ore when she ran aground on Docking shoal on the 25th February 1916~

Condition: ~ Although she has been sunk for 95 years at the highest point she is 7mtr proud of the sea bed, the iron propeller is still in place and the funnel is lying on the sea bed the mid ships area has now collapsed inwards~
