History: ~Sunk 4th June 1941. Built in 1911 by Harland for the Shaw Saville and Albion Line. Then bought by the Admiralty on 28th September 1939 as a Fleet Tender and immediately converted to represent HMS Hermes. Powered by two double boilers two single boilers and twin quadruple expansion engines driving twin shafts. While on passage for Chatham she became Stranded on the Ahamo and was a sitting duck for a German U Boat!~
